



Thank you for your interest in visiting the Shipley Art Gallery!

We hope this resource pack will support you in making a visit with your class. It includes an overview of our workshops and pricing, along with important information about planning and making a visit with your students.

Exploring an art gallery can be a rewarding experience for children and adults of all ages. From our historical permanent collection to our exciting temporary exhibitions, the Shipley truly has something to offer everyone! After a group visit, students are encouraged to use the gallery and its resources outside of school time with their family and friends, as part of an approach to fostering informal life-long learning. **We hope that you and your students find your visit to the Shipley Art Gallery a very enjoyable and enriching experience!**

Planning your visit

- **General admission to the Shipley Art Gallery is free. Our temporary exhibitions may have an admission charge - please check our website for details.**
- **Advanced booking is essential for workshops and self-led visits. To avoid disappointment, please book your visit at least two weeks in advance.**
- **A space for lunch is available for schools to use and must also be booked in advance.**
- **We offer facilitated workshops for schools Wednesday - Fridays, and in-school, outreach workshops on Wednesday and Thursday, subject to availability.**
- **We can accommodate 32 students per workshop and our adult to child ratio is: 1:6 (Years 1 - 3) / 1:10 (Years 4 and above).**
- **A hazard identification form can be provided upon request to help you prepare a risk assessment for your visit.**

Year Round School Workshop Programme

We offer 7 year-round workshops, in addition to our temporary workshop programme, so you can easily combine two half-day activities for a full day visit to the Shipley! Or book individual sessions for a morning or afternoon at the gallery.

Workshop	Description	Length	Cost
Blaydon Races KS1/2	Explore characters and local history through the Shipley's painting of the Blaydon Races by William Irving. Children will take part in guided discussions, handle Victorian artefacts and dress up as characters from the painting.	1 hour 30 minutes	£90
Textiles with Feltmaking KS1/2	Investigate different textiles in the collection and find out about how textiles are used in traditional North Eastern crafts. Children will handle various textiles before having a go at making their own felt square in the art studio.	1 hour 30 minutes	£90
Clay Containers KS1/2/3	Explore the contemporary craft and decorative art collections in the Shipley's collection. Pupils will then have a go at making their own clay container using the collection as inspiration.	1 hour 30 minutes	£90
Making an Angel KS1/2	Pupils will compare and contrast the maquette of the Angel of the North with the monumental sculpture. Children will participate in discussion, drawing, model making and games.	1 hour 30 minutes	£90
Pattern and Decoration KS1/2	Investigate patterns using the Shipley's craft and design collection. Children will develop their own designs through experimenting with symmetry and repeating patterns before making a collaged piece using Michael Brennand Wood's piece as inspiration.	1 hour 30 minutes	£90
The Object of this story is... KS1/2/3	A creative enquiry and writing workshop using the quirky collection of objects from the Saltwell Park Museum exhibition as inspiration.	1 hour 30 minutes	£90
Super Shipley tour KS1/2/3/4	Led by our experienced art educators, your students will take part in an interactive tour of the Shipley Art Gallery. Students will find out about key pieces from the collection through short art activities and games.	1 hour	£75
